MEMORANDUM

- 1 On June 13, 2011, Puget Sound Energy, Inc. (PSE), filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) certain tariff revisions designed to increase rates for electrical and natural gas services provided to customers in Washington. PSE’s initial filing included testimony in support of its request, including the prefiled direct testimony of Jon A. Piliaris.
- 2 PSE filed a Motion for Leave to File Supplemental Testimony and Exhibit (Motion) on November 9, 2011. PSE’s Motion seeks leave to update the testimony and exhibit of PSE witness Jon A. Piliaris to add one customer to its electric rate Schedule 40 and to reflect the revenue requirement in the testimony of another PSE witness, John H. Story. PSE states that it recently became aware that one of its customers met the qualification standards for electric service under Schedule 40 and that customer had not been included in that rate schedule. PSE contends that the supplemental testimony results in a \$70,000 increase in the company’s electric revenue deficiency. Mr. Piliaris’ supplemental testimony was attached to PSE’s Motion.
- 3 The Commission afforded the parties an opportunity to respond to PSE’s Motion. None of the parties did so.
- 4 PSE states that it only recently became aware that this additional customer was eligible for service under electric rate Schedule 40 because several meter locations

serving the customer were not coded properly to the correct distribution feeder in the company's customer information system.

- 5 As none of the parties have objected, and given the importance of a full and complete record, the Commission determines that PSE's Motion should be granted.

ORDER

- 6 The Commission grants the Motion for Leave to File Supplemental Testimony and Exhibit, filed by Puget Sound Energy, Inc.
