The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered its Order 06, Final Order Approving and Adopting, Subject to Conditions, Multiparty Settlement Agreements and Authorizing Transaction, in Docket UT-090842 on April 16, 2010. The Order required Frontier Communications Northwest, Inc., (Frontier) to report annually the results of six service quality metrics and provide a one-time annual bill credit to customers for any missed metrics.<sup>1</sup>

On August 1, 2011, Frontier filed with the Commission its 2011 Service Quality Annual Report Card, and supplemented the filing on August 23, 2011.

The Commission has examined the filing and has determined it is complete. Therefore, the Commission accepts the filing described above.
