The Commission adopted and repealed rules relating to carriers of household goods by General Order No. 454 on December 14, 1998, filed at WSR 99-01-077. The intention of the Commission Staff, of stakeholders in the process, and of the Commission was unanimously to exclude from the repeal of existing rules those rules that relate to the operation of common carrier brokers. This intention is reflected in the minutes of the adoption hearing, in the Commission Staff memorandum that has been adopted as an element of the Concise Statement of the Commission's reasoning for taking its actions, and in representations about the effect of the rulemaking.

Through a scrivener's error, however, the Commission inadvertently repealed one of the sections relating to common carrier brokers. WAC 480-12-375 was inadvertently repealed in the Order of Adoption, General Order No. 454, dated December 14, 1998, and in the rule text filed with the Code Reviser. WAC 480-12-370, relating to carrier insurance, was inadvertently excluded from repeal.

By this order, the Commission corrects the error. References in the original General Order No. 454 and in the text accompanying the order are hereby changed to <u>exclude</u> WAC 480-12-375 from repeal and, by exclusion, to effect the repeal of WAC 480-12-370. This correction will take effect pursuant to RCW 34.05.380.
