1. Public Counsel hereby offers this Public Comment Exhibit No. 11 for admission into the record of the proceeding.
2. Public Comment Exhibit No. 11. The exhibit consists of letters, emails and other written materials submitted by the public to provide comment on the Pacific Power & Light Company's general rate case. These letters and materials were submitted to the Commission and to the office of Public Counsel.
