

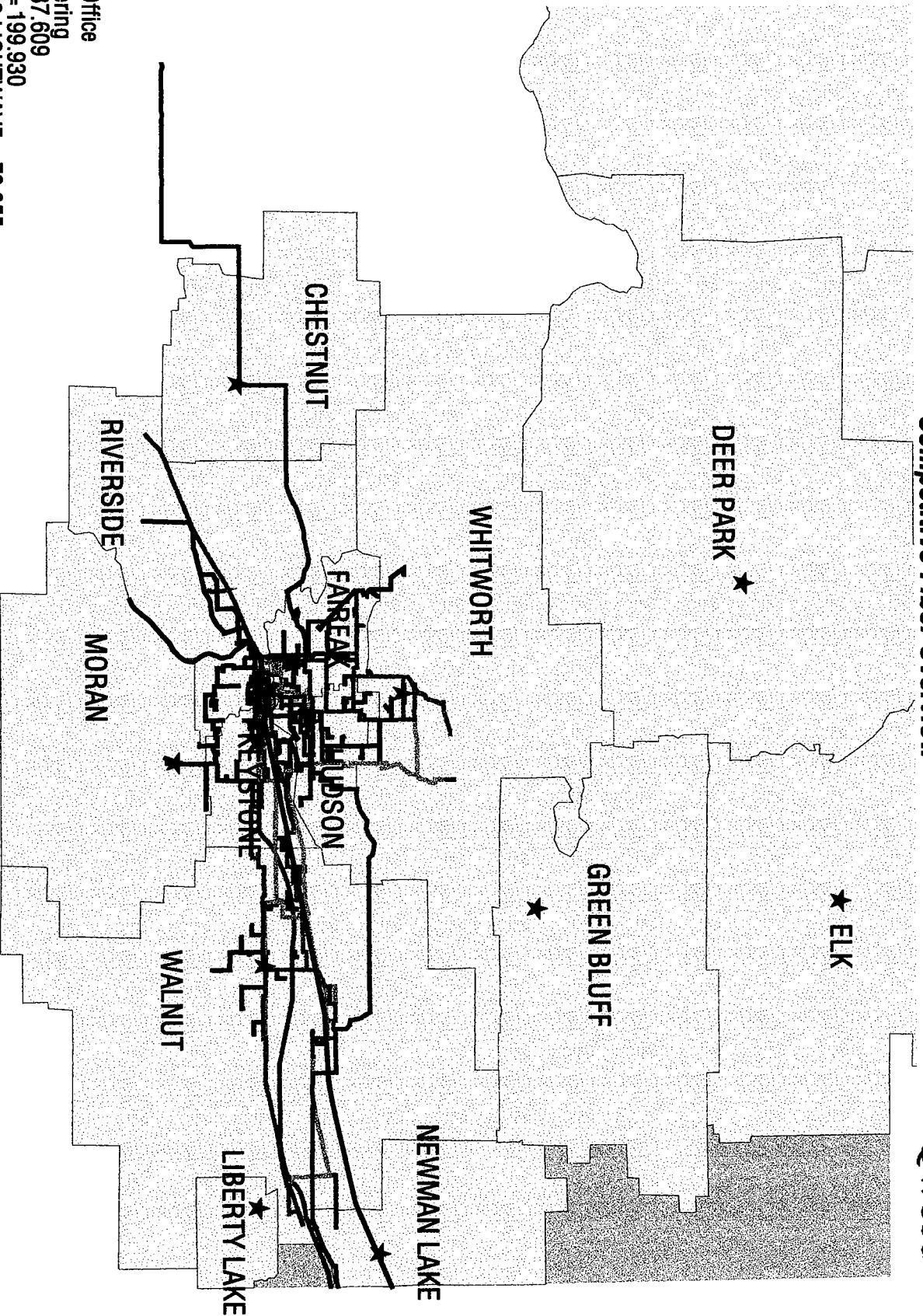
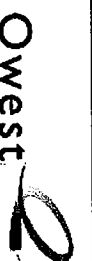
SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE DATED MAY 3, 2006:
