Re: Vaporizer Capabilities

The PSCAA permit limits vaporizer usage to 240 hours in a <u>12 month</u> period. How much LNG can be vaporized using the Tacoma LNG vaporizer in 240 hours?

Response:

The Tacoma LNG Facility's use of the Vaporizer is limited to a maximum gas-injection of 66,000 Dth/day based on the volume of gas that can be injected into the Puget Sound Energy distribution system. This corresponds to a maximum injection volume of 660,000 Dth which is equivalent to approximately 7.5 million gallons.
