- On April 3, 2002, AT&T Communications of the Pacific Northwest, Inc. filed with the Commission a complaint against Verizon Northwest, Inc. (Verizon). The complaint alleges that Verizon's switched access charges far exceed Verizon's cost of providing that access. The complaint further alleges that Verizon is using revenues generated by excessive switched access rates to fund a "price squeeze" designed to force competitors from toll markets in Washington. A more detailed account of the dispute is reflected in the complaint which is available for inspection at the Commission's office located at Chandler Plaza Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington. It is appropriate that the matters raised in the pleadings be brought for hearing before the Commission.
- Hearing in this matter is being held pursuant to Part IV of chapter 34.05 RCW pertaining to adjudicative proceedings, including but not being limited to RCW 34.05.413, RCW 34.05.431, RCW 34.05.440, RCW 34.05.443, RCW 34.05.449, RCW 34.05.452, and RCW 80.01.100. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter under Title 80 RCW, having legal authority to regulate the rates, services, and practices of telecommunications companies providing service within the state of Washington and to hear complaints brought by one public service company against another such company. Statutes and rules cited in the complaint include 47 U.S.C. § 251(h), 47 U.S.C. § 251(c)(2)(D), 47 U.S.C. § 252(d)(2), 47 U.S.C. § 253(a), 47 U.S.C. § 254(f), RCW 80.01.040, RCW 80.04.110, RCW 80.36.140, RCW 80.36.180, RCW 80.36.186, WAC 480-09-400, and WAC 480-120-540. In addition to the foregoing, statutes and rules involved include those within chapter 80.36 RCW, chapter 480-09 WAC, and chapter 480-120 WAC. The issues involved are generally stated above and more specifically contained in the complaint.
