Q. Please state your name and business address.

A. My name is Sandra M. Sieg. My business address is 355 110th Avenue NE, P.O. Box 90868, Bellevue WA 98009-0868.

Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?

A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy, Inc. ("PSE") as the Program Manager of the Low Income Weatherization Program.

Q. What are your duties as the Program Manager for the Low Income Weatherization Program?

A. As the Program Manager for the Low Income Weatherization Program, I have overall responsibility for (i) distributing conservation tariff dollars to social service agencies to install weatherization measures in the home of income-eligible PSE customers; (ii) tracking and reporting program activity; and (iii) planning, forecasting and communicating program activity to outside parties.

6 Environmental Protection Agency, where I worked in a variety of divisions to
7 develop skills in budgeting, leadership, policy, management and systems analysis,
8 and public outreach and community relations. From 1990 to 1995, I was a
9 regulatory analyst, scientist, and outreach specialist for the Wetlands Division at
10 the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, where I received two high-level
11 awards for commendable service.

12 From 1995 to 2008 I specialized in community education working at the Pacific
13 Science Center in Seattle; I operated a small business as a community education
14 entrepreneur, and I became a facilitator for the Powerful Choices for the
15 Environment Program at PSE. The National Speakers Association has recognized
16 me as a professional speaker and association member since 2007.

17 In April 2008, I was named to my current position as the Program Manager for
18 the Low Income Weatherization Program at PSE.
