Gold Beach Water Company, Inc. was granted a tariff revision with the Commission to cover a CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT loan. Commission approved a Surcharge tariff of \$5 per month per customer which became effective on March 1, 2008. Since our billing cycle is every two months, the surcharge first appeared on the May 1, 2008 billing.

At the rate of \$5 a month x 2 months = \$10 per billing cycle. We are currently billing 191 customers x \$10 every 2 months = \$1,910. collected over each billing period. Gold Beach Water opened a dedicated surcharge account at U.S. Bank - Account # 153560693910 on July 16, 2008. The opening deposit was \$1,910. (191 x \$10. = \$1,910.)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED SURCHARGE

GOLD BEACH WATER COMPANY, INC. has asked the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) for permission to add a first time surcharge of \$5 per month - to the basis rates we currently charge our customers which were approved on July 1, 2006. This surcharge will become effective on March 1, 2008 if it is approved by the commission.

We have applied for a 2007 Drinking Water State Revolving Fund loan for \$192,607. to be repaid at an interest rate of 1.5 percent over the next 20 years or sooner. The Capital Improvement loan covers the construction of a storage tank at our hilltop location and the addition of a pressure booster pumping station to improve the overall system pressure in upper Gold Beach. The surcharge will expire when the loan is fully repaid. The surcharge will be added to your monthly billing, however, your basic rates will not change because of this filing.
