TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a notice on March 15, 2010, that it would review Avista Corporation's (Avista) integrated resource plan (IRP) for natural gas service at a public meeting on April 15, 2010. On April 8, 2010, the Commission rescheduled the review of Avista's IRP to a recessed open meeting to be held on Thursday, April 29, 2010, at 1:30 p.m. **By this notice, the Commission reschedules the review of the IRP to occur immediately following the regular open meeting on Thursday, April 29, 2010, which is scheduled to begin at 9:30 a.m.** The meeting will be held at the Commission's headquarters, Room 206, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.

An "integrated resource plan" describes the mix of generation and supply resources and efficiency improvements that will meet both the current and future energy demands at the lowest cost to the utility and its ratepayers.

Avista representatives will present the plan to the Commission and will respond to questions from the Commissioners and the public. A copy of the plan is on file in the library at the Commission's offices in Olympia. Requests for copies of the plan, if needed, should be directed to Avista, not the Commission.
