On April 27, 2009, the Commission assessed a penalty of \$2,700 against Cordia

Communications Corp. (Cordia) and \$18,000 against Northstar Telecom, Inc. (Northstar) for multiple violations of WAC 480-120-166. The Commission received from Cordia and Northstar Applications for Mitigation on May 12, 2009 (electronically) and 18, 2009 (hard

copy). Commission Staff supports partial mitigation of the penalties for the reasons set forth

in the attached declaration of Sheri Hoyt.
