Dear Mr. Danner,

On July 16th, 2010, Rabanco Ltd. (dba Allied Waste of Lynnwood, Lynnwood Disposal, Maltby Division) filed revised tariff pages in conjunction with a request to update the commodity credit given to our single family and multi-family customers.

Following the Washington Utilities & Transportation Commission (Commission) Open Meeting on August 26<sup>th</sup>, 2010 an order was issued requesting that we develop a budget with Snohomish County detailing the amount of revenue we plan to retain and the amount of money we plan to spend associated with the 2010/2011 Revenue Sharing Plan ("Plan") that was developed concurrently. We worked with county Staff to develop the attached budget and came to agreement on expenses related to items outlined in the Plan aimed at benefitting the County's recycling programs and consistent with the Snohomish County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan.

The costs associated with the Plan are specific to the activities outlined in the plan and are not included in Allied Waste of Lynnwood's tariff rates for recycling or other services. Costs associated with the Revenue Sharing Plan are excluded from any general rate case filing.

In addition, it was ordered that we petition the Commission to lift the interim status that was placed on our revenue sharing at the meeting.

We would request that this letter and the attached documents serve as our petition to the Commission. Included with this petition are:

- Detailed budget outlining the amount of revenue expected to be retained and anticipated expenditures associated with the 2010/2011 Recycling Plan
- 2010/2011 Recycling and Commodity Revenue Sharing Plan for Snohomish County
- Certification Letter from Snohomish County
