Errata to Order 01 of Docket #TC-101813

Dear Mr. Danner:

Evergreen Trails, Inc. ("Evergreen") files this letter requesting the Commission to issue an errata to Order 01 for TC-101813, dated December 21, 2010. The errata is necessary to correct the new language of Evergreen's revised certificate, C-819 ("Certificate"). The Commission revised the Certificate pursuant to the Joint Application ("Application") of Shuttle Express, Inc. ("Shuttle") and Evergreen to allow Shuttle to operate Evergreen's Seattle-Tacoma Airport to downtown Seattle hotels route.

On page 2 of the revised Certificate, Evergreen's retained authority is stated as follows:

"1. Service hereunder is expressly limited to the transportation of airline passengers and flight crews between Seattle-Tacoma Airport on the one hand, <u>and water in Seattle</u> on the other hand, at rates substantially higher than the fares of regular common carriers."

The revised Certificate should have read as follows (copied from the Application). Evergreen's proposed revisions are italicized and bolded.

"1. Service hereunder is expressly limited to the transportation of airline passengers and flight crews between Seattle-Tacoma Airport on the one hand, <u>and water transportation offices and facilities</u> in Seattle on the other hand, at rates substantially higher than the fares of regular common carriers."
