On July 12, 2011, Advanced Telecom, Inc. d/b/a Integra; Electric Lightwave, LLC d/b/a Integra; Eschelon Telecom of Washington, Inc d/b/a Integra Telecom; Oregon Telecom Inc. d/b/a Washington Telecom d/b/a Integra; Unicom f/k/a United Communications, Inc. d/b/a Integra¹; McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services L.L.C. d/b/a PAETEC Business Services; and tw telecom of washington llc (collectively, Joint CLECs) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation

Commission (Commission) a complaint against Qwest Corporation and CenturyLink, Inc. (collectively, Qwest/CenturyLink). The Joint CLECs allege that Qwest/CenturyLink have violated Order 14² in Docket UT-100820 and the terms of various settlement agreements approved in that same docket regarding Operational Support Systems, also referred to as "OSS", used for maintenance and repair. A more detailed account of the dispute is reflected in the complaint, which is available for inspection at the Commission's office located at Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington, and on the Commission's web site at www.utc.wa.gov/111254. It is appropriate that the matters raised in the pleadings be brought for hearing before the Commission.

- On August 2, 2011, Qwest/CenturyLink filed an answer to the complaint.
- STATUTORY AUTHORITY: The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter under RCW Title 80 and has legal authority to regulate the rates, services, and practices of telecommunications companies providing service within the state of Washington. The statutes that apply to this matter include RCW 80.01, RCW 80.04, and RCW 80.12 relating to rates, including but not limited to RCW 80.01.040, RCW 80.04.020, and RCW 80.04.110. The rules that apply to this matter include those within WAC 480-07, WAC 480-120, and WAC 480-143.
- The Commission will hear this matter under the Administrative Procedure Act (APA), particularly Part IV of RCW 34.05 relating to adjudications. The provisions of the APA that relate to this proceeding include, but are not limited to RCW 34.05.413, RCW 34.05.422, RCW 34.05.431, RCW 34.05.440, RCW 34.05.449, and RCW 34.05.452. The Commission will also follow its procedural rules in WAC 480-07 in this proceeding.
- THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a prehearing conference in this matter at 1:30 p.m., on Thursday, August 25, 2011, in the Commission's Hearing Room, Second Floor, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. - The purpose of the prehearing conference is to consider requests for intervention, resolve scheduling matters including establishing dates for distributing evidence and workpapers, to identify the issues in the proceeding and determine other matters to assist the Commission in resolving the matter, as listed in WAC 480-07-430.
- INTERVENTION: Persons who wish to intervene should file a petition to intervene in writing at least three business days before the date of the prehearing conference. See WAC 480-07-355(a). The Commission will consider oral petitions to intervene during the conference, but strongly prefers written petitions to intervene. Party representatives must file a notice of appearance with the Commission no later than the business day before the conference. See WAC 480-07-345(2). Any party or witness in need of an interpreter or other assistance should fill out the form attached to this notice and return it to the Commission. The Commission will set the time and place for any evidentiary hearings at the prehearing conference, on the record of a later conference or hearing session, or by later written notice.
