Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on June 6, 2014, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against National Moving & Storage, Inc. in the amount of \$1,000 for violation of WAC 480-15-480, which requires household goods carriers to file an annual report with the Commission and pay regulatory fees by May 1 each year. National Moving & Storage, Inc. failed to file its annual report for 2013 or paid its 2014 regulatory fee and has incurred a penalty of \$1,000. The Commission sent National Moving & Storage, Inc. a Final Notice on August 13, 2014. On August 21, 2014, the Commission granted your request for a payment arrangement. To date, no payments have been received by the Commission.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$1,000 balance.
