To: All 206, 253, 360, 425 NPA Code Holders and Other Industry Members (Washington)

Subject: Request for Second Industry NPA Relief Option Review Conference Call

At the request of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC) staff, NANPA will conduct a second industry meeting to review the 360 NPA status and to obtain industry input on two NPA Overlay scenarios for the state of Washington. An agenda, a list of the two overlay options, a CO Code Summary Report and a Pooling Statistics Report are attached. The UTC staff wishes for industry comment on the two NPA overlay options that would best fit the number exhaust relief needs for the 206, 253, 360, and 425 NPAs. Currently, there exists a suspended all services overlay over the four western Washington NPAs with the new 564 NPA. The UTC has kept 7-digit and 10-digit permissive dialing in place. Based on the November 2015 NRUF Forecast, the projected exhaust dates of the western WA NPAs are as follows: 360 NPA in 1Q2019, 206 NPA in 1Q2029, 425 NPA in 4Q2046 and the 253 NPA in 2Q2059.

The UTC staff will use additional input from this meeting in their recommendation to the Commission on going forward with area code relief in western Washington. The purpose of this call is to solicit industry input on the overlay options and to discuss the impacts of each one. This call is intended as an informal means for the industry to assist the UTC staff recommendation to the Commission considering relief along with any service provider concerns. No final decisions will be made during this meeting; however meeting notes will be published.
