NOTICE OF INTENT TO SUSPEND CERTIFICATE AND OPERATING AUTHORITY

- On March 30, 2016, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Order Granting Mitigation to \$1,000, reducing the penalty assessed against Good & Goods, LLC d/b/a The Original Cannabus (Good & Goods or Company) for 17 violations of WAC 480-30-221. That order required the Company to pay the mitigated penalty no later than April 13, 2016.
- Commission records indicate that Good & Goods has not paid the penalty. The Company's failure to pay the penalty is, itself, a violation of applicable law for which the Commission can impose additional penalties. Such disregard of a Commission order also calls into question Good & Goods' fitness to provide regulated passenger transportation services. This conduct is cause to suspend the Company's Certificate and Authority to provide charter and excursion service pursuant to WAC 480-30-171(1) until Good & Goods pays the penalty and otherwise complies with its regulatory obligations.
- THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it intends to suspend the Certificate and Operating Authority of Good & Goods to provide passenger transportation services. Pursuant to WAC 480-30-171(4), the Company may contest the pending suspension by requesting a hearing or brief adjudicative proceeding within 10 days following the date of this notice.
