Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on February 13, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against MVP Moving and Storage LLC in the amount of \$6,100 for violations of WAC 480-15-570 and WAC 480-15-555, which govern the regulation of household goods carriers. On July 12, 2017, the Commission issued Order 03 granting a payment arrangement for the remaining \$3,000. MVP Moving and Storage LLC failed to make payments as established in Order 03. As of September 18, 2017, the balance of \$2,200 remains unpaid.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$2,200 balance.
