NOTICE OF BRIEF ADJUDICATION

SETTING TIME FOR ORAL STATEMENTS

(Set for April 18, 2019, at 9:30 a.m.)

- On January 23, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Penalty Assessment in Docket DG-180992 against Aero Construction (Aero or Company) in the amount of \$20,000, alleging two violations of Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 19.122.030(2), for failing to provide the required notice to a one-number locator service not less than two business days before excavating, and one violation of RCW 19.122.030(6)(c), for failing to provide additional notification of continued excavation to facility operators using the one-call notification system.
- On February 5, 2019, Aero filed with the Commission a contest of penalties and request for hearing. Aero denies two of the three alleged violations and requests a hearing before an administrative law judge to present evidence.
- Pursuant to RCW 34.05.482 and WAC 480-07-610, the Commission determines that a brief adjudicative proceeding is appropriate for determining whether the violations occurred.
- THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a brief adjudicative proceeding in this matter at 9:30 a.m., on Thursday, April 18, 2019, in Room 206, Second Floor, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.
- The record in this case will consist of any documents regarding the matter that are considered by or prepared for the presiding officer for the brief adjudicative proceeding and a transcript of any oral statements given at the hearing, which statements will be given under oath.
- Written notice of any other stage in the proceeding or other formal proceedings that the Commission may deem appropriate will be given during the course of this case. The

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Commission will provide at its offices in Olympia, Washington, copies of documents in the current record for use by the parties or others who may want to review them.

- Parties wishing to submit any other documents for consideration at the brief adjudicative proceeding must file with the Commission all such documents, as well as a list enumerating such documents, no later than **5 p.m. on Thursday, April 11, 2019**, and bring an original and one (1) copy to the hearing. Filing shall be in accordance with WAC 480-07-140.
- THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that any party who fails to attend or participate in the brief adjudicative proceeding set by this Notice, or any other stage of this proceeding, may be held in default under RCW 34.05.440 and WAC 480-07-450.
