RE: Commission Staff's Letter Confirming Compliance D-190243– Johansen Excavating, Inc. aka Johansen Construction Company, Inc. -Investigation # 7945

Dear Ms. Maxwell:

Commission staff (staff) has reviewed the compliance order for Johansen Excavating, Inc. aka Johansen Construction Company, Inc. (JCC or Company) dated August 12, 2019. Compliance with the order required the following items be met:

• \$1,000 penalty for one violation of RCW 19.122, with the opportunity to suspend, and ultimately waive the entire \$1,000 penalty amount if the Company incurs no other dig law violations within 24 months.

On August 22, 2019, JCC signed and agreed to the Penalty Assessment conditions. The Company has not incurred any additional violations of the dig law since the date of the Penalty Assessment.

Staff believes JCC has fully complied with the Commission's order, and further compliance under this order is no longer necessary. Staff recommends the Commission waive the suspended \$1,000 penalty amount and close the docket.
