RE: *In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against Lee A. Lamb, d/b/a Lamb's Disposal,*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On July 2, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a \$1,000 penalty against Lee A. Lamb d/b/a Lamb's Disposal (Lamb's Disposal or Company) for 39 critical-type safety violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-70-201, which adopts Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations Parts 391, 395, and 396, discovered during a June 2019 compliance review conducted by Commission staff (Staff).

On July 2, 2019, Commission entered Order 01, Order Granting Mitigation to \$500; Imposing and Suspending Penalty (Order 01) against Lamb's Disposal. Order 01 assessed a penalty of \$500 against Lamb's Disposal, \$250 of which was suspended for two years, to be waived thereafter, subject to the conditions that: (a) Lamb's Disposal does not incur any repeat violations.

On October 13, 2021, Staff filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that the Company had timely paid the \$250 portion of the penalty that was not suspended, and that upon reinspection, Lamb's Disposal did not incur any repeat violations.

The Commission finds that Lamb's Disposal has complied with the conditions of Order 01. The \$250 portion of the penalty that was suspended is now waived, and this docket is closed.
