2. Charter is a registered competitive local exchange carrier in the State of Washington, authorized to provide both intraexchange and interexchange telecommunications services throughout the state. Charter currently has an interconnection agreement with Frontier Communications Corporation ("Frontier") in Washington and is a wholesale customer of Frontier's products, both through its interconnection agreements and through tariffs.

3. Charter has a substantial interest in the proposed transfer of control of Frontier to Northwest Fiber, LLC ("Northwest Fiber"). Northwest Fiber is a newly created entity owned by two investment funds, WaveDivision Capital VII, LLC (in turn an investment fund of WDC Management, LLC), and investment funds affiliated with Searchlight Capital Partners, L.P. (referred to collectively as "Searchlight"). Charter relies on interconnection with, and related services obtained from, Frontier to offer and provide service to Charter's customers in Frontier's service territory. Charter seeks to participate in this proceeding to ensure that the proposed transaction will not adversely impact competition in Washington or Charter's rights and ability to obtain the interconnection and related services it needs to provide its competitive voice services.

- 4. The evidence, if any, and briefing presented by Charter will be of material value to the Commission in its determination of the issues involved in this proceeding, and Charter's intervention will not broaden those issues or delay the proceedings.
