TO ALL PARTIES:

On January 6, 2023, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Denying Request for Hearing; Granting Mitigation to \$5,200; Imposing and Suspending Penalty (Order 01). Order 01 reduced the assessed penalty against Sky Harbor Shuttle LLC (Sky Harbor Shuttle or Company) from \$10,100 to \$5,200 and then suspended a \$2,600 portion of the reduced penalty for a period of two years, to be waived, subject to the following conditions: 1) The Company pay the \$2,600 portion of the penalty that was not suspended or file a mutually agreeable payment plan with Staff within 10 days of this Order; 2) Commission staff (Staff) conduct a follow-up investigation of the Company's operations approximately two years after the effective date of the Order; and 3) The Company not incur any repeat critical or acute violations upon reinspection.

On February 4, 2023, the Company paid in full the \$2,600 portion of the penalty that was not suspended.

On October 24, 2024, Staff completed the required follow-up investigation, which resulted in a satisfactory safety rating. The Company did not incur any repeat critical or acute violations.

On January 7, 2025, Staff filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that it believes the Company has satisfied the conditions of Order 01 and recommending that the \$2,600 suspended penalty be waived.

The Commission finds that Sky Harbor Shuttle has complied with the conditions of Order 01. The \$2,600 suspended portion of the penalty is hereby waived, and this docket is closed.
