Dear Residential Customer,

This is to notify you of a proposed rate change for residential services in Walla Walla County and Columbia County where Basin Disposal of Washington, LLC operates. Should the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) approve our request, customers will experience a rate increase throughout all classes of service.

Collection Services Will Be Billed Every Two Months

As you may be aware, it has been about thirteen years since our last general rate case. In that time, Basin Disposal of Washington, LLC has experienced significant increases in costs that are essential to delivering services, including labor, insurance, fuel, maintenance expenses, along with federal and state employment taxes. In addition, the company continues to acquire new assets to ensure it can deliver the safest, most efficient and reliable service possible. If approved, the proposed rates will become effective on June 1, 2023.

The proposed rate increase for our Residential services is approximately 30.49%, and not all offered services are listed above. Residential services will be switching from monthly billing to bimonthly billing. The Commission has the authority to set final rates that may be either lower or higher than the company's request, depending on the results of its investigation.
