TO ALL PARTIES:

On June 15, 2023, the City of Bingen filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a petition to construct a railroad-highway grade separation at Elm Street in the City of Bingen, Washington, (Petition) over railroad tracks belonging to BNSF Railway (BNSF).

On July 10, 2023, the Commission issued a Notice of Prehearing Conference (Notice) scheduling a virtual prehearing conference on August 2, 2023, at 1:30 p.m.

On July 31, 2023, the Commission issued a Notice Continuing Prehearing Conference, that rescheduled the prehearing conference to August 23, 2023, at 10:30 a.m.

On August 21, 2023, the Commission issued a Notice Continuing Prehearing Conference, that rescheduled the prehearing conference to February 15, 2024, at 10:30 a.m.

On February 9, 2024, the parties notified the presiding officer that the City and BNSF are continuing to negotiate an agreement. The parties requested a continuance of the prehearing conference until June 2024 to allow sufficient time to complete negotiations.

The Commission finds good cause to continue the prehearing conference until June 18, 2024, at 10:30 a.m.
