Consistent with prior reports, PacifiCorp is also enclosing a summary of short-term sales and purchases by counterparty. While this summary provides additional transparency and granularity, due to the unique nature of how the Company's net power costs are calculated in Washington, amounts provided in the counterparty summary will not tie to actual net power costs.
