On December 11, 1990, Robert A. Hart filed a formal complaint against the respondent water company, alleging that the company had violated state statutes and Commission rules in provision of water service.

A hearing was held on the complaint at Olympia, Washington, on June 7, 1991, before Administrative Law Judge Alice L. Haenle.

On July 30, 1991, the administrative law judge entered an initial order which was served on all parties of record.

Twenty days have passed since the order was entered and not petition for administrative review has been filed by any affected party of record. In accordance with RCW 34.05.464 and WAC 480-09-780(7), the Commission accepts the findings of fact and conclusions of law and adopts the initial order as its own for purposes of this proceeding.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED That the initial order in Docket No. UW-901534 is affirmed and adopted for purposes of this proceeding. In so doing,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That Robert Hart will pay to the company within thirty days of the Commission's order in this matter, \$87 for commercial water service May through September 1990; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the remainder of the bill for commercial water service to the market, located adjacent to complainant's residence, is cancelled, and the company will cease billing for water service to the market; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That, so long as no water service is taken by the market, and so long as conditions of water use otherwise remain as they are described in the initial order, the market shall not be considered a commercial water customer under the company's tariff; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the remaining prayers of the complaint and answer are denied.
