The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) filed a Preproposal Statement of Inquiry (CR-101) regarding conservation incentives on April 6, 2010, at WSR # 10-08-075. The Commission has decided not to proceed with this rulemaking proceeding and requests that the CR-101 published in WSR # 10-08-075 be withdrawn.

On November 4, 2010, the Commission issued, to all interested persons in the rulemaking docket, a report and policy statement on regulatory mechanisms, including decoupling, to encourage utilities to meet or exceed their conservation targets. The Commission filed today, for publication in the state register, a notice regarding the policy statement.
