On September 12, 2011, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Bench Request No. 3 regarding Frontier Communications Northwest, Inc.'s (Frontier or Company) second request for disbursement of funds from its escrow account. The Company filed its Response on September 19, 2011, providing both general and specific objections to much of the data requested.

As you know, the Commission requires sufficient information to track and verify Frontier's progress towards the broadband deployment goals set forth in Order 06. Given the company's response to some of the items set forth in Bench Request No. 3, I fear there may be a misunderstanding about the intent of the Bench Request and the scope of information sought. I propose we sit down in person with Commission staff and Company representatives so that we can come to a common understanding and resolve these issues going forward.
