On March 15, 2004, Avista made a compliance filing as required by the Commission's Sixth Supplemental Order in this case. In the compliance filing, Avista proposes that the Benchmark Mechanism Tariff No. 163 be extended until April 30, 2004, when it will be allowed to expire. Avista also proposes that the company will move the mechanism functions back to Avista Utilities from Avista Energy over the period May 1, 2004 until March 31, 2005.

Avista indicates that it circulated the compliance proposal to the parties, but does not state whether the parties agree with the proposal.
