## Re: Docket UE-200420—PacifiCorp's 2023 Integrated Resource Plan Update

PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp or Company) submits for filing its supporting workpapers for the analyses included in the 2023 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) Update.

Confidential workpapers are provided in accordance with WAC 480-07-160. Confidential workpapers include model input and results, and support for tables and figures organized by chapter and appendix. This includes materials for all studies, variants and sensitivities report in the April 1, 2024 filing. PacifiCorp will provide the confidential and highly confidential electronic materials under WAC 480-07-160. These confidential and highly confidential materials are spreadsheets and data files containing confidential and highly confidential information as defined in WAC 480-07-160(2)(b) and (d), and RCW 80.04.095.<sup>1</sup> Specifically, the files contain competitively sensitive and proprietary information including contract pricing, detailed load forecasts, and detailed resource cost data and third-party proprietary modeling information. Disclosure of the information in these files would result in an unfair competitive disadvantage and result in financial harm to the Company. This financial harm will result from the Company's inability to negotiate lowest-cost pricing and contract terms will be disclosed on the public record. This financial harm would ultimately harm ratepayers if PacifiCorp is required to incur greater costs associated with providing electric service.
