## **MEMORANDUM**

- NATURE OF PROCEEDING: Docket UT-063061 involves Qwest Corporation's (Qwest) request for arbitration of an interconnection agreement with Eschelon Telecom, Inc., (Eschelon) pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §252(b) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.
- 2 PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND: The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) convened a prehearing conference in this docket at Olympia, Washington, on November 6, 2006, before Administrative Law Judge Patricia Clark. In Order 05, Prehearing Conference Order, the Commission established a modified procedural schedule at the request of the parties. That procedural schedule did not include all necessary deadlines. At the request of the parties, a second prehearing conference was scheduled to establish additional procedural deadlines.

- *3* **PREHEARING CONFERENCE:** The prehearing conference convened, as scheduled, on November 6, 2006. At the prehearing conference, the parties agreed to additional procedural deadlines.
