This supplemental response shows the changes in average residential bills from 1988 through 2004. The data is based on the application of tariffs to a representative level of kwh consumption in each district. The BPA residential exchange is included where available.

The data shows that average bills for PacifiCorp's Washington customers increased by 12% in this time period. For Washington customers served by Avista and PSE bills increased by over 20%. During the same time period, PacifiCorp's Utah customers realized an actual decrease in their bill of about 8%.

The "Average KWH" column of the figures in the lower table are rounded figures from the information in the top table. The figures in the top table are not weather adjusted data.
