Pursuant to paragraph 11 of the Prehearing Conference Order, Order 03, Public Counsel files this follow-up status report regarding PacifiCorp's customer notice in the above-captioned general rate case.

Representatives from Public Counsel, PacifiCorp, and UTC Consumer Affairs (the parties) worked together to refine the format and content of the notice. On April 7, 2008, Public Counsel filed an initial status report stating that discussions between the parties were on-going and requesting to file this follow-up status report.

On May 7, 2008, PacifiCorp circulated a final draft of the notice to the parties. PacifiCorp, Public Counsel, and UTC Consumer Affairs are in agreement that the individual customer notice meets the requirements of WAC 480-100-194 and -197. PacifiCorp has informed the parties that customers will receive the notice approximately one month before the September 25, 2008, Public Comment Hearing. <sup>1</sup>
