- On September 17, 2001, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered an order requiring number pooling in area code 360. The Washington Independent Telephone Association (WITA) on September 24, 2001, requested a change to the ordering clause to correct an inconsistency within the order.
- The correction sought by WITA should be made. The ordering paragraph referred to number pooling in rate centers with "switches capable of local number portability" when the appropriate reference was to number pooling in rate centers "where local number portability has been implemented."
- The Commission corrects the first ordering paragraph of its September 17, 2001, order to read:
 - (1) The Commission directs the state's interim number pooling administrator, Neustar, Inc., to initiate a number pooling trial in all rate centers in area code 360 where local number portability is implemented and to conduct the first implementation meeting for the trial by September 27, 2001.
- The Commission considered this request at its open meeting of October 10, 2001, and directed the Commission's Executive Secretary to enter this order to effect the Commission decision.
