- 5 During the call on April 22, 2020, Pacific Power's counsel offered to provide Staff with the raw data inputs that the Company submitted to the Oregon Public Utility Commission (OPUC), but declined to produce, in response to DR 223, complete versions of the requested testimony and exhibits of OPUC witness Moya Enright in Docket No. UE 356 and the unredacted versions of the OPUC's decision in Docket No. UE 356.
