Dear Judge O'Connell:

The parties to the consolidated dockets referenced above have reached a partial multiparty settlement in principle and are notifying the Commission in keeping with WAC 480-07-740(2)(c).

The settlement in principle does not include the issues in Docket UE-180778, and this is why it is a partial and not a full settlement. Settlement discussions in Docket UE-180778 are ongoing.

The partial settlement in principle is not an all-party settlement at this time because the Public Counsel Unit of the Washington Attorney General's Office (Public Counsel) has yet to receive authority to enter into the settlement. Once it is known whether Public Counsel will be joining the settlement, the parties will propose a procedural schedule for the Commission's review of the settlement.

The parties intend to file the settlement and supporting testimony on July 17, 2020. In the meantime, the parties ask the Commission to suspend the existing procedural schedule but to hold the existing hearing date of August 24, 2020.
