## TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND PARTIES:

On December 13, 2019, PacifiCorp, d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp or Company), filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to its currently effective tariff, WN U-75 for Electric Service, designed to effect an increase in revenues of \$3.1 million from its Washington operations, offset by amortization of remaining deferred tax benefits associated with the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of approximately \$7.1 million, resulting in an overall rate reduction of \$4 million, or approximately 1.1 percent. On January 9, 2020, the Commission suspended operation of the tariff revisions by issuing Order 01, Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revisions.

On February 3, 2020, the Commission issued Order 03/01/06 consolidating Dockets UE-191024, UE-190750, UE-190929, UE-190981, and UE-180778 and, among other things, established a procedural schedule that allowed for a public comment hearing to be scheduled at a later date.

The Commission now establishes the time and place for a virtual public comment hearing to provide members of the public with an opportunity to present oral comments to the Commission.
