- 1 The Commission convened brief adjudicative proceeding on July 6, 2001, on this complaint to consider suspending the registration of 54 telecommunications companies for failure to pay regulatory fees and file annual reports before Administrative Law Judge Lawrence J. Berg.

- 2 On July 18, 2001, the administrative law judge entered a brief written statement resolving the issues, in the form of an initial order WAC 480-09-500 (4). Of the 54 respondents, one company complied with its legal duties and was dismissed from this proceeding. Another company requested that its registration be cancelled by the Commission. The initial order proposed that the registrations of the other 52 companies be revoked. The initial order was served on all parties of record pursuant to WAC 480-09-500 (3) and WAC 480-09-120.

- 3 No objection to the initial order was made within the 21 days allowed by rule and law. In accordance with RCW 34.05.485 and WAC 480-09-500 (6), the Commission accepts the findings of fact and conclusions of law, and adopts the Initial Order as its own for purposes of this proceeding.

ORDER

- 4 The Commission affirms and adopts the Initial Order entered in this brief adjudication on July 18, 2001, for purposes of this proceeding. In so doing, The Commission

revokes the registrations of the 52 telecommunications companies identified in Appendix A to this Order.
