On May 16, 2003, Island Airporter, LLC., filed application D-79171 in accordance with Chapter 81.68 RCW for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to furnish passenger and express service .

Subsequently, on June 9, 2003, interested parties were notified of the filing of said application to give them an opportunity to express their views either for or against the granting of this application.

After reviewing the evidence submitted and due to the fact that no service of an existing nature is presently available over this route, the Commission deems it expedient to issue the requested authority without a hearing pursuant to Chapter 81.68.040 RCW. Further, the Commission finds that the applicant is fit, willing, and able to properly conduct the proposed operation and it appears that the service sought to be rendered is necessary and will be a convenience to the public.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED That Application D-79171 herein be and the same is hereby granted, conditioned upon compliance with the laws and rules governing auto transportation companies, and that a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity be issued to Island Airporter, LLC., to read as follows:

PASSENGER SERVICE

Between: San Juan Island and the Seattle-Tacoma International Airport via the Washington State Ferry Service to Anacortes.

Closed-door service between San Juan Island and the Seattle-Tacoma International Airport.

Note: All passengers must have Seattle-Tacoma International Airport as an origin or destination.
