- Household Goods Carrier Permit No. HG-1855 stands in the name of United Moving & Storage, Inc., and authorizes the transportation of household goods in the state of Washington.
- On March 29, 2005, an application was filed under the provisions of chapter 81.80 RCW, and chapter 480-15 WAC rules relating to household goods carriers for authority to enable John Loidhamer, Shauna Washburn, and Craig Loidhamer, to acquire control of United Moving & Storage, Inc., through purchase of corporate stock.
- The application includes statements supporting a transfer of permanent authority under the exceptions of WAC 480-15-260. The applicant is fit, willing and able to acquire control of the requested permit and it appears that the permanent acquisition of control as requested will not be detrimental to the interests of the public.
- The Commission having considered the application and being fully advised finds that the existing service is needed to satisfy the public convenience and necessity and it would be in the public interest to grant the application pursuant to the provisions of WAC 480-15-330.
