Dear Representative:

We have just received a letter from Point Recycling and Refuse stating that we may be in jeopardy of losing our garbage collection service because it is financially unfeasible for the refuse collection company to continue curbside recycling .

We have a recreational home here on the Point and have used the services of Point Recycling and Refuse for many years on an as needed basis using prepaid stickers for the cans. This has worked well for us as we are on the Point sporadically.

We have been very satisfied with the service provided by Mr. Wilkowski's company and really appreciated the free recycling service provided at the refuse site . We strongly believe Mr. Wilkowsky has done his best to accommodate the vacation customers as well as the permanent ones even though it is hard to run a business with such erratic population increases and decreases as seasons pass. Loss of this service will lead to littering and garbage dumping around the Point, thus despoiling this beautiful environment. We have had this in the past and do not want this for the future.

Point Roberts is a unique entity and cannot be treated with the same requirements as larger communities. WUTC should reexamine its position on this matter before we lose this vital service.
