The Coalition appreciates the opportunity to comment on the Cascade Natural Gas Integrated Resource Plan (IRP). We have participated in the Cascade IRP advisory group process and acknowledge that Cascade is developing its resource planning capabilities.

While the Coalition recognizes that Cascade is not currently subject to decoupling or conservation requirements similar to those of their electric utility counterparts, if similar mechanisms were in effect we would not interpret a goal to secure 75% of achievable conservation savings to be sufficient.

Furthermore, the Coalition would like to express concerns with the industry-wide trend for natural gas utilities to ramp up and down conservation programs as gas prices fluctuate. We are not as confident that natural gas prices will remain as low as they are projected to be over the long term due to the environmental ramifications of shale gas extraction. Stable program offerings are critical to building customer awareness, participation and confidence and maintaining a strong base of trade allies and enthusiastic retailers.

Instead of monitoring legislative building code changes as outlined in Cascade's 2year action plan, the Coalition would like to encourage Cascade to be an active participant in the code making process. As the lowest cost energy savings available, utilities have an interest in ensuring code savings occur.
