1 On March 9, 2012, BML Investments LLC, d/b/a Wenatchee Valley Shuttle, filed an application in Docket TC-120337 with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) under RCW 81.68 and WAC 480-30, to provide service as a passenger transportation company. The service requested is as follows:

Passenger Service between Wenatchee and Seattle-Tacoma International Airport, with intermediate stops at Peshastin.

2 The application appeared on the March 14, 2012 application docket. Interested parties were notified of the filing of the application to give them an opportunity to express their views either for or against the granting of this application.

3 After reviewing the evidence submitted, and due to the fact that no service of this nature is presently available over this route, the Commission issues the requested authority without a hearing pursuant to RCW 81.68.040.

4 Further, the Commission finds that the applicant is fit, willing, and able to properly provide the proposed service and that the proposed service is necessary and will be a convenience to the public.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

5 (1) The application of BML Investments LLC, d/b/a Wenatchee Valley Shuttle, in Docket TC-120337 is granted, conditioned upon compliance with the laws and rules governing passenger transportation companies, and that a certificate of public convenience and necessity is issued to BML Investments LLC, d/b/a Wenatchee Valley Shuttle, to read as follows:

PASSENGER SERVICE BETWEEN Wenatchee and Seattle-Tacoma International Airport, with intermediate stops at Peshastin, **by reservation only.**

Charter and Excursion services in the state of Washington.

- 6 (2) The tariff and time schedule for BML Investments LLC, d/b/a Wenatchee Valley Shuttle, filed in connection with this application will become effective at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the service date of this Order.
- 7 The Commission has delegated authority to the Secretary to enter this Order under RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-905(6)(a).

NOTICE: This is an order delegated to the Secretary for decision. In addition to serving you a copy of the decision, the Commission will post on its Internet Web site for at least 14 days a listing of all matters delegated to the Secretary for decision. You may seek Commission review of this decision. You must file a request for Commission review of this order no later than fourteen (14) days after the date the decision is posted on the Commission's Web site.

The Commission will schedule your request for review by issuing a notice of hearing to be held before an administrative law judge. The Commission, at its discretion, may consider your request for review in an adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05 Part IV, or in a brief adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05.482 through .494. Following hearing, the administrative law judge will enter an initial order. If you wish to seek review of the initial order, you may file a petition for administrative review under RCW 34.05.464, or if the matter is heard in a brief adjudicative proceeding, under RCW 34.05.491.

The Commission will grant a late-filed request for review only on a showing of good cause, including a satisfactory explanation of why the person did not timely file the request. A form for late-filed requests is available on the Commission's Web site.

This notice and review process is pursuant to the provisions of RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-

07-904(2) and (3), and WAC 480-07-905, as amended effective September 22, 2008.
