NOTICE EXTENDING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION TO DISMISS (By June 21, 2016)

TO ALL PARTIES:

On May 17, 2016, Shuttle Express, Inc. (Shuttle Express) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a Formal Complaint Against Speedishuttle Washington, LLC (Speedishuttle) for its Rules, Regulations, or Practices in Competition with Complainant that are Unreasonable, Insufficient, Unremunerative, Discriminatory, Illegal, Unfair, or Tending to Oppress the Complainant (Complaint).

On June 7, 2016, Speedishuttle filed a Motion to Dismiss Complaint of Shuttle Express, Inc. (Motion).

On June 9, 2016, Shuttle Express contacted the Commission and requested a four day to extension to respond to Speedishuttle's Motion. Neither Speedishuttle nor Commission staff objects to Shuttle Express's request. Based on the parties' agreement, the Commission finds good cause to extend the deadline for responding to Speedishuttle's Motion until 5 p.m. on June 21, 2016.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the parties may respond to Speedishuttle Washington, LLC's Motion to Dismiss Complaint of Shuttle Express by filing a written response with the Commission no later than 5 p.m. on June 21, 2016.
