NOTICE OF BRIEF ADJUDICATIVE
PROCEEDING

SETTING TIME FOR ORAL
STATEMENTS
**(Set for December 5, 2017,
9:30 a.m.)**

- 1 On June 2, 2017, Cruising Transportation Company LLC d/b/a Cruising Shuttle (Cruising Shuttles or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application for Auto Transportation Certificate (Application). Notice of the Application was served on interested persons on October 5, 2017.
- 2 Cruising Shuttles' Application requests authority to provide door-to-door passenger service between points in King, Snohomish, Pierce, and Thurston counties.
- 3 On October 25, 2017, Shuttle Express, Inc. filed a protest to the Application. On November 3, 2017, Pacific Northwest Transportation Services, Inc. d/b/a Capital Aeroporter also filed a protest to the Application.
- 4 Pursuant to RCW 34.05.482 and WAC 480-07-610, the Commission determines that a brief adjudicative proceeding is appropriate for resolving the issues in this matter.
- 5 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a brief adjudicative proceeding in this matter at 9:30 a.m., on Tuesday, December 5, 2017, in Room 206, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.**
- 6 The record in this case will consist of any documents regarding the matter that are considered by or prepared for the presiding officer for the brief adjudicative proceeding and a transcript of any oral statements given at the hearing, which statements will be given under oath.

- 7 Written notice of any other stage in the proceeding or other formal proceedings that the Commission may deem appropriate will be given during the course of this case. The Commission will provide at its offices in Olympia, Washington, copies of documents in the current record for use by the parties or others who may want to review them.
- 8 In accordance with WAC 480-30-136(2), the Commission requests that the parties file by November 28, 2017, the following documents for consideration at the brief adjudicative proceeding:
- (1) Statements from independent witnesses provided by an objecting company to demonstrate that the objecting company is providing the same service as the proposed service, to the satisfaction of the commission.
 - (2) Statements from independent witnesses provided by an objecting company to demonstrate that the traveling public will be harmed by the granting of the application.
 - (3) Additional supplementary information, evidence, or testimony provided by the applicant to demonstrate that public convenience and necessity requires the proposed service.
- 9 The Commission also requests that parties file a list enumerating and describing any such documents **no later than 5 p.m. on Tuesday, November 28, 2017**, and bring an original and three (3) copies of any such documents to the hearing. Filing shall be in accordance with WAC 480-07-140(5).
- 10 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that any party who fails to attend or participate in the brief adjudicative proceeding set by this Notice, or any other stage of this proceeding, may be held in default under RCW 34.05.440 and WAC 480-07-450.**
