

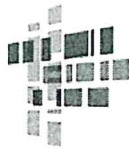

DESCRIPTION OF VOICE SERVICES RATE COMPARABILITY - §54.313(a)(10)

SKYLINE TELECOM, INC.'s Voice Services Pricing is no more than two standard deviations above the applicable urban rate floor for voice services. On December 20, 2018, the Wireline Competition Bureau ("Bureau") established the 2019 average urban floor rate of \$26.98 and a maximum of \$51.61 as the Rate Comparability Benchmark. The FCC's previously announced that the phase-in of the floor rate was frozen at \$18.00 by the FCC (May 17, 2017) and the FCC recently eliminated the Floor Rate on April 12, 2019 in FCC 19-32 but continued reporting for one year. SKYLINE TELECOM, INC.'s total residential voice service rate plus mandatory state fees is no more than \$19.50 for the 556 Exchange and \$25.00 for the 804 Exchange. When all state and federal mandatory charges are added to SKYLINE TELECOM, INC.'s residential voice service rate the total rate is below the \$51.61 Rate Comparability Benchmark set by the Bureau.

SKYLINE TELECOM, INC.'s Broadband Services Pricing meets the FCC's broadband public interest obligations because it offers broadband service at actual speeds of at least 10 Mbps downstream/1 Mbps upstream at no more than the applicable benchmark for broadband services announced by the Bureau on December 20, 2018 (DA 18-1280).

SKYLINE TELECOM, INC. offers broadband service at actual speeds of 10 Mbps downstream/1 Mbps upstream with no usage allowances for \$54.95. Since the Bureau's Benchmark Table for 2018 included in DA 18-1280 indicates that broadband service of 10 Mbps downstream/1 Mbps upstream with no usage allowances should be offered at no more than \$77.30, SKYLINE TELECOM, INC.'s 10 Mbps downstream/1 Mbps upstream broadband service offering at \$54.95 meets the Bureau's requirement for broadband reasonable comparability service rates.


