Commission Staff Recommendation to Impose Suspended Penalties of Order 01
Docket TV-190082

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On April 29, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) entered Order 01, Granting Mitigation, In Part; Imposing and Suspending Penalty in Docket TV-190082. Order 01 granted InMove LLC's (InMove or company) request for mitigation, assessed a penalty of \$5,100, and suspended a \$2,550 portion of the penalty for two years, and then waived, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Commission staff (staff) conduct a follow-up investigation within two years, or as soon thereafter as practicable;
- (2) InMove must not incur any repeat violations of critical regulations during those two year; and
- (3) the company must pay the \$2,550 portion of the penalty that is not suspended within 10 days of the date of the order.

On May 1, 2019, the company paid the \$2,550 non-suspended portion of the penalty in full.

On April 20, 2021, staff completed the follow-up review as required in Order 01. During the follow-up review, staff identified one repeat violation of a critical regulation. InMove failed to run a criminal background check for employee Juan Carlos Arriage prior to the hire date of April 10, 2020. A criminal background check was acquired for Juan Carlos Arriage on March 15, 2021.

Staff finds that InMove failed to satisfy each requirement of Order 01 by incurring a repeat violation of a critical regulation and recommends that the \$2,550 suspended penalty be imposed.
