Re: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Dockets TV-200875/200876 (Consolidated)

Dear Mr. Coyle:

As you are aware, on October 28, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment on Ed's Moving & Storage in the amount of \$17,500 for violations of the Commission's laws and rules. On December 9, 2020, the Commission issued Order 01 imposing and suspending penalties. On October 12, 2021, Commission Staff filed a letter in these dockets stating that Ed's Moving & Storage failed to comply with the terms of Order 01, and requesting that the Commission impose the suspended portion of the penalty. On November 17, 2021, a Final Notice was sent to Ed's Moving & Storage in the amount of \$3,800, which was due on receipt. To date, the Commission has not received the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You will likely incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to the outstanding \$3,800 balance.
