TO ALL PARTIES:

On August 11, 2023, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Intent to Cancel Permit as a Household Goods Carrier; Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding; Setting Time for Oral Statements (NOIC) against Zen Moving PLLP, d/b/a 2 Pure Moving – Man With A Truck Moving (Zen Moving or Company). The NOIC, among other things, scheduled a brief adjudicative proceeding (BAP) for September 1, 2023.

On August 31, 2023, Commission staff (Staff) informed the presiding administrative law judge by email that the parties reached a settlement in principle, and that the Company had waived its right to a hearing. Staff requested that the Commission cancel the scheduled brief adjudicative proceeding.
